✔ Regular Check-Ins

Schedule regular check-ins to discuss the employee's progress and address any concerns or additional accommodation needs.

✔ Assign a Buddy/Mentor

Pair the new employee with a buddy or mentor to help them navigate the workplace and integrate into the team.

✔ Provide Accessible Training

Ensure all training programs and materials are accessible and tailored to the employee's learning style.
